SPECIAL EXPERIENCE

ENDO-VASCULAR INTERVENTION

In addition to my Basic Endovascular experience which I gained during my Vascular Surgery Training at St. James's Hospital in Dublin (Ireland), during my career and all the Conferences, Symposia and Workshops, I spent three months of full-time Endovascular Intervention training at the internationally renowned center at Park-Krankenhaus Hospital of the University of Leipzig in Germany. During this period of dedicated training, I participated and assisted in over five hundred (500) cases of Endovascular procedures for the Carotid, Vertebral, Renal and Lower Limb arteries in addition to the Thoracic and Abdominal Aortic stent grafting.

- This is the most famous and busiest internationally renowned center in Endovascular Interventions all over the world.
- It is directed by Professor Dierk Scheinert and is run by his senior consultant Dr. Andrej Schmidt. Both of them are world famous in Endovascular Intervention. All the staff comes from Interventional Cardiology and Angiology background. None of them are radiologists.
- It attracts vascular surgeons and interventional physicians from all over the world.
- The Center organizes at least three International Conferences per year; LINC (Leipzig Interventional Course) and Two LINC Expert Forums.
- It participates in at least three major Annual International Vascular Congresses through live Case Transmissions, namely: Charing Cross Vascular and Endovascular Symposium in London, Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI) this year in Paris and Veith Vascular Symposium in New York.
- The catheter laboratory has three rooms; one of them is equipped for hybrid vascular procedures. The lab performs around twenty-five (25) procedures per day, an average of eight (8) cases per room.
- During my intensive training period as a full time attendant, I actively participated and assisted, with hands on experience, in around five hundred (500) endovascular cases, an average of forty (40) cases per week.
- During the same period, I attended fifteen (15) different company workshops and four (4) International conferences.
- I gained great experience in performing conventional angiography, selective angiography, vessel sizing, balloon angioplasty and deployment of appropriate size stents and stent grafts. I also became very conversant in using different sheaths, including cross over ones, wires and catheters. I also gained daily experience in using vascular closure devices, especially Angioseal→ and Proglide→, the latter as pre- and post-loaded.

I gained specific experience in the following areas:

- Supra-Arch Interventions including Brachio-cephalic, Subclavian and Vertebral arteries.
- Carotid Artery Stenting using both Distal Embolic Protection Devices (EPDs) and proximal MOMA systems.
- Intra-Cerebral Interventions including the use removable stents in cases of Acute Embolic Stroke.

- Renal Artery Stenting.
- Renal Denervation using Radio-Frequency Ablation catheters for patients with uncontrolled hypertension.
- Thoracic Endo-Vascular Aortic Repair (TEVAR) for Thoracic Aortic Aneurysms and Acute Aortic Dissection.
- Endo-Vascular Aortic Repair (EVAR) for Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm including the use of Chimney and custom-made Fenestrated Grafts.
- Endovascular Stenting for Aorto-Iliac segment Occlusion, including use of covered stents.
- Endovascular Intervention for Superficial Femoral Artery stenosis and total occlusion.
- Endovascular Intervention for Femoro-Popliteal segment stenosis and occlusion including the use of the new SUPERA→ stent for heavily calcified arteries, Drug-Eluting Stents (DES) and Drug (DCBs)-Coated Balloons.
- Endo-Vascular Intervention for Below-The-Knee (BTK) stenosis and Chronic Total Occlusions (CTOs) including Retrograde technique and the use of DES and DCBs.
- Endovascular Intervention using Mechanical Thrombectomy Catheters (ROTAREX).
- Endovascular Intervention using Tom-Hawke and Silver-Hawke Atherectomy catheters.
- Endovascular Intervention techniques for Endo-Leak after EVAR using wire embolization and Amplatz plugs.

VASCULAR SURGERY

While working in the Department of Vascular Surgery at St. James's University Hospital I received a specialized training in the field of Peripheral Vascular Surgery and Non-Invasive Vascular Laboratory assessment, namely:

- Measurement of Segmental Pressures and Trans-Cutaneous Partial Pressure of Oxygen (TCPO₂).
- Duplex and Triplex Scanning of Carotid and Lower Limb Arteries.
- Doppler ultrasound and Triplex scanning of patients with primary Varicose Veins and those with Deep Vein Disease (DVT).
- Carotid End-Arterectomy (CEA) for symptomatic patients with severe Carotid Artery Stenosis. I was first assistant or operator in over 150 such operations.
- Elective and Emergency Repair of Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA). Arterial Bypass surgery for patients with Lower Limb Ischemia, using vein and Prosthetic grafts.
- Digital and major Limb Amputations.
- Trans-Thoracoscopic Electro-Cautery (TTEC) of thoracic sympathetic chain for patients with primary Palmar Hyperhidrosis and those with Raynaud's disease.
- Percutaneous Transluminal balloon Angioplasty (PTA) with or without Endovascular Stents and Prosthetic Grafts, using C-Arm and Digital Subtraction Angiography (DSA) in the Operating Theater.
- Conservative management of Chronic Venous Ulcers.
- Surgery for Primary Varicose Veins by the new "Varady" technique, using Iridotomy (Beaver) knife and Varady hook. I performed around 800 (eight hundred) such operations.

GENERAL SURGERY

While working for Mr. Quill, Department of Surgery, St. James's Hospital, Trinity College, Dublin, Ireland, I accumulated the following special, advanced experience in General Surgery:

- Extensive use of Upper and Lower GIT Endoscopies.
- Extensive use of GIT Staplers including GIA, TA and CEEA, for small and large bowel resections.
- Surgery for Carcinoma of the Stomach and Colo-Rectum including Low Anterior Resections.
- Breast and Parathyroid surgery
- Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy including Intra-Operative Cholangiography.

EXPERIMENTAL SURGERY

During the years 1985 and 1986 and under the supervision of Prof. A. Shafik (Cairo University), I conducted the practical part of my **MSc Thesis** on "*Experimental Model of Varicocele in Dogs*". In this model I successfully induced unilateral Varicocele in fourteen mongrel dogs by total excision (De-Tubation) of the Fascio-Muscular covering of the Spermatic Cord. The study proved the importance of the Fascio-Muscular covering in the pathogenesis of Varicocele and the effect of unilateral Varicocele on bilateral Testicular functions. The results were used to develop few innovative operations to strengthen the weak cord coverings in patients with primary Varicocele instead of the usual excision of varicose veins. These new operations included multiple fine Chromic Purse-String sutures or Fascia Lata grafting of the cord or Tunica Vaginalis flap around it.

RESEARCH WORK

I concluded the results of Non-Invasive and Clinical assessment of 151 Transluminal balloon Angioplasties (including the use of Stents and Endoluminal Grafts) in 108 patients with Lower Limb Ischemia, performed during the period from January 1993 to April 1994. I was also involved in two other research projects on Venous Surgery. One paper addressed the problem of Recurrent Varicose Veins, which comprised up to 20% of our work on Primary Varicose Veins. The other one discussed the Anatomical Variations at the Sapheno-Femoral Junction (SFJ) in one hundred consecutive explorations and its importance in recurrent varicose veins. Right now, together with my colleagues at the College of Medicine in Abha, we are conducting studies on the structural changes in the wall of varicose veins at both the light and the Electron microscopic levels.

MEDICAL EDUCATION

As part of my job in St. James's University Hospital for three and a half years, I used to enjoy giving Tutorials to Undergraduate students during their clinical years and to Postgraduate students preparing for their Final Fellowship Examinations. In the present job, I teach the undergraduate medical students in their clinical years and examine the final M.B.B.Ch. medical students. I served as the *coordinator* of Surgery-1 Course for five years (1996 – 2001). I gained good experience in editing multiple choice questions (MCQs) and in organizing conventional clinical and OSCE examinations. Regarding postgraduate teaching program, I train Arab and Saudi board surgical residents in Vascular Surgery and provide postgraduate lectures and bed-side teaching.
